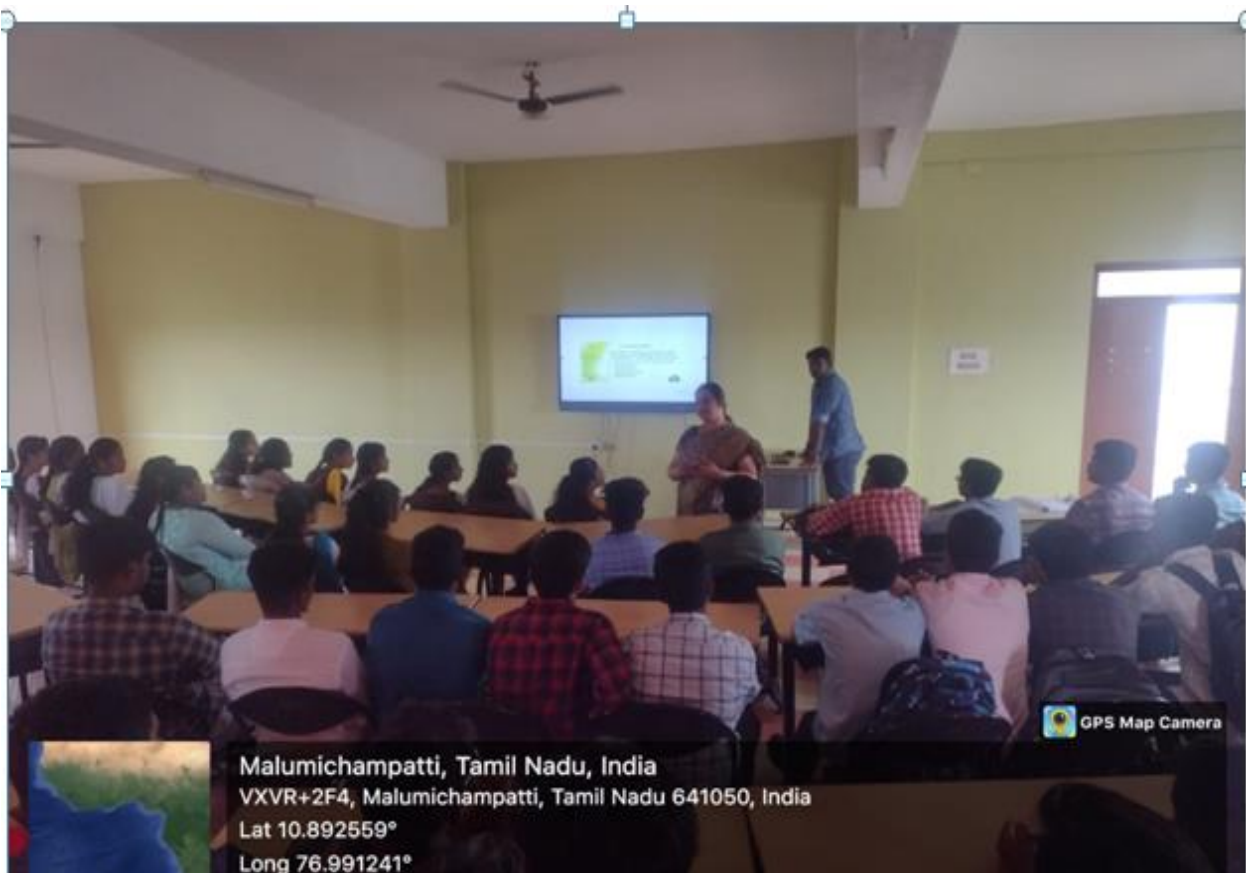
The first-year Student Induction Programme (2023) was held from 12th September until 23rd September. Around 1,200 students actively participated in the programme.

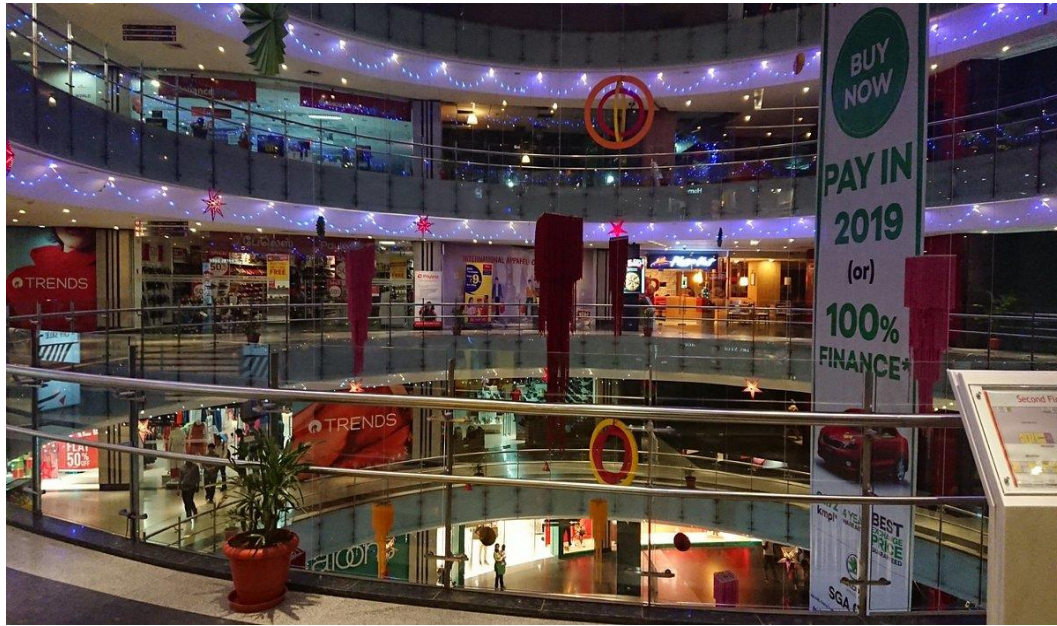
ISHA


YOGA PROGRAMME

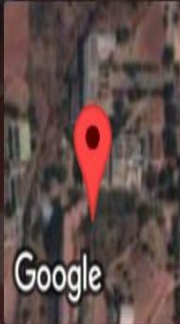
E-WASTE MANAGEMENT

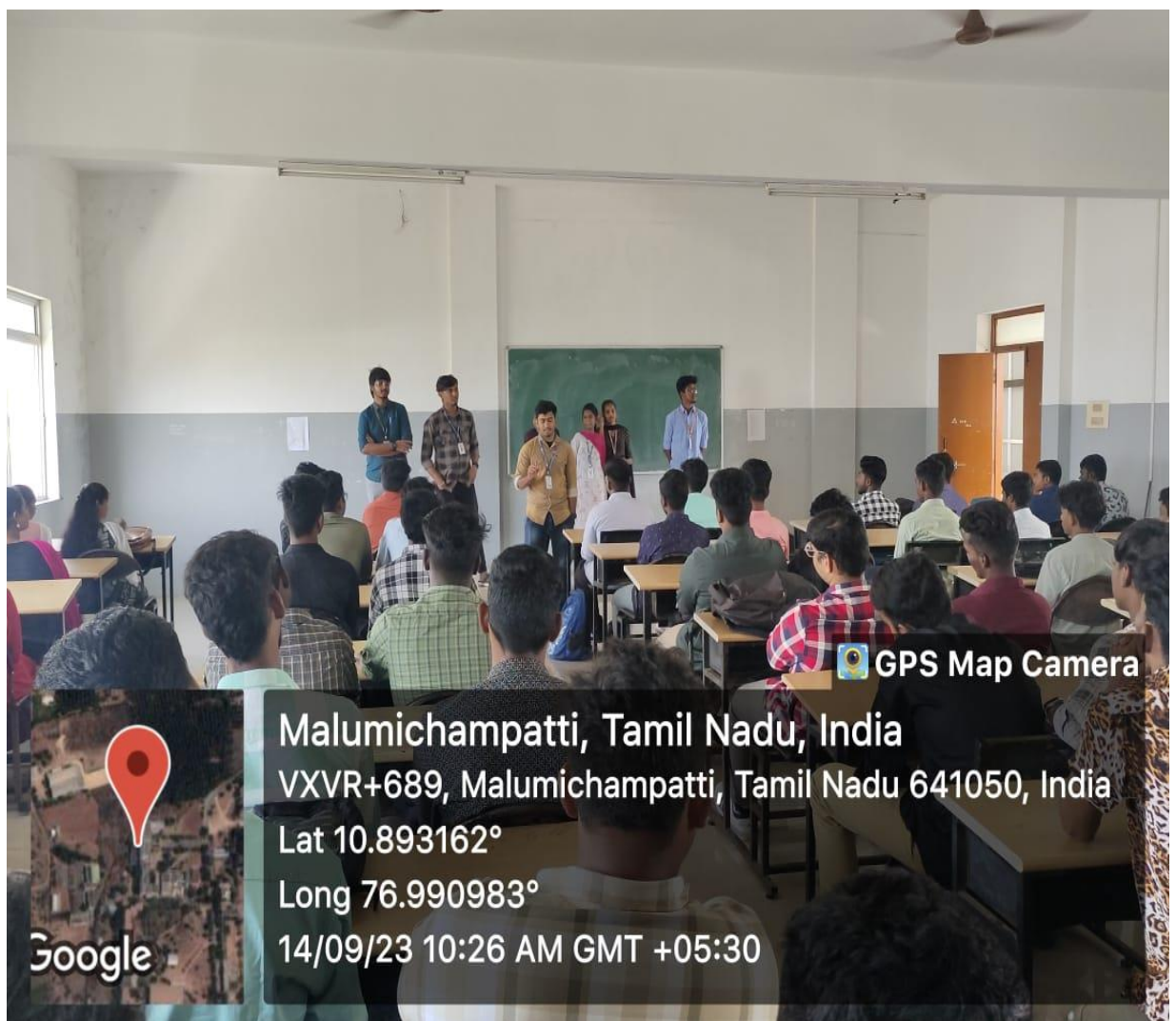
